

PROPOSED NEW LANGUAGE

- a. TK and Kindergarten teachers will teach no more than two hundred eighty (280) minutes per day.
 1. All Day TK and Kindergarten
 - i. The District will provide recess supervision for TK-K.
 - ii. TK and K teachers shall provide Orientation Day –first day of the school year, new parent orientation, (Kindergarten Roundup – In Jan. or Feb.), and Open House at the end of the school year. They shall not be required to attend Back to School Night.
 - iii. The first instructional day shall be a shortened student day. The remainder of that first week will be minimum days for students and work days for teachers.
 - iv. Each classroom will have two hours of aide time, one before and one after lunch break beginning the first full week of class.
 - v. Combo TK /K and all K/1 combination classes will be capped at 20 students No additional students will be added.
 - vi. The District will ensure that each TK-K classroom be cleaned once at the end of each day (trash, floors, and wiping of the tables).
 - vii. Each TK –K Teacher shall receive a \$500 stipend for 2015/2016.
 - viii. For the 2016/2017, 2017/2018 years each TK –K classroom will receive an additional \$500 above site allocations. In the subsequent years an ongoing sum above site allocations of \$200 per TK-K teacher will be allocated.
 - ix. One Wednesday of each month (minimum day or PLC time) will be for site collaboration and program development determined by the site TK and K teachers. This provision expires in 2019/2020.
