(Related to Initial Proposal Regarding Hours for Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten)

ARTICLE XIX - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

C. Duty Aides

1. The District agrees to provide morning and afternoon bus/yard duty aides for grades K-6. These aides will supervise the children on the school grounds before and after the instructional day.
2. The District will provide recess duty aides for grades 1-6. These aides will supervise the children during recess.
3. The District will provide Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten classes a minimum of one hour of instructional aide time per day.

43. Teachers may be asked to supervise buses or recess on an occasional basis in the absence of an aide or in an emergency situation.

54. On rainy days, teachers are entitled to a 30-minute duty-free lunch and will be expected to report back to their classrooms to supervise their class.

5. Sites providing full day Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten will receive a classroom supply budget that consists of a one-time contribution by the District as follows:

1. Pine Ridge and Cedarwood- \$1,000
2. Paradise Elementary and Ponderosa - \$2,500

6. For the 2016-17 school year, the district will provide Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten teachers with two days of release time to further develop the extended day kindergarten program.
