INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

WARNING:

READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY.

DO NOT ASSUME THAT IT IS THE SAME AS OTHER SIMILAR DOCUMENTS YOU MAY HAVE SEEN, EVEN IF FROM THE SAME DISTRICT.

- Preparation of Bid Form. Bids shall be submitted on the prescribed Bid Form, and Bid Form Pricing Sheet and completed in full. All bid items and statements shall be properly and legibly filled out. Numbers shall be stated both in words and in figures where so indicated, and where there is a conflict in the words and the figures, the words shall control over the numbers. The signatures of all persons shall be in longhand and in ink (preferably "blue" ink). Prices, wording and notations must be in ink or typewritten.
- 2. Form and Delivery of Bids. The bid must conform and be responsive to all bid documents and shall be made on the Bid Form and Bid Form Pricing Sheet provided, and the complete bid, together with any and all additional materials as required, shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed and hand delivered or mailed to Paradise Unified School District, 6696 Clark Road, Paradise, CA 95969, and must be received on or before the bid deadline (Public Contract Code Section 20112 The District will not accept bids that are submitted electronically). The envelope shall be plainly marked in the upper left hand corner with the respondent's name, the bid number and the date and time for the opening of bids. It is the bidder's sole responsibility to ensure that its bid is received prior to the bid deadline. In accordance with Government Code Section 53068, any bid received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids shall be returned to the bidder unopened. At the time and place set forth for the opening of bids, the sealed bids will be opened and publicly read aloud.
- 3. <u>Bid Pricing</u>. Bid prices are to include the cost of all furniture items (with a rate sheet detailing each item price), tax, shipping, installation and setup, logistics and any storage and warehouse fees.
- 4. <u>Signature</u>. Any signature required on bid documents must be signed in the name of the bidder and must bear the signature of the person or persons duly authorized to sign these documents. Where indicated, if bidder is a corporation, the legal name of the corporation shall first be set forth, together with two signatures: one from among the chairman of the board, president or vice president and one from among the secretary, chief financial officer, or treasurer. Alternatively, the signature of other authorized officers or agents may be affixed, if duly authorized by the corporation. Such documents shall include the title of such signatories below the signature and

shall bear the corporate seal. Where indicated, in the event that the bidder is a joint venture or partnership, there shall be submitted with the bid certifications signed by authorized officers of each of the parties to the joint venture or partnership, naming the individual who shall sign all necessary documents for the joint venture or partnership and, should the joint venture or partnership be the successful bidder, who shall act in all matters relative to the joint venture or partnership. If bidder is an individual, his/her signature shall be placed on such documents.

- 5. <u>Modifications</u>. Changes in or additions to any of the bid documents, alternative proposals, or any other modifications which are not specifically called for in the bid documents may result in the rejection of the bid as being nonresponsive. No oral, telephonic, facsimile or electronic modification of any of the bid documents will be considered.
- 6. <u>Erasures, Inconsistent or Illegible Bids</u>. The bid submitted must not contain any erasures, interlineations, or other corrections unless each such correction is authenticated by affixing the initials of the person(s) signing the bid in the margin immediately adjacent to the correction. In the event of inconsistency between words and numbers in the bid, words shall control numbers. In the event that any bid is unintelligible, illegible or ambiguous, the bid may be rejected as being nonresponsive.
- 7. Examination of Site and Bid Documents. At its own expense and prior to submitting its bid, each bidder shall examine all bid documents; visit the sites and determine the local conditions which may in any way affect the performance of the work; familiarize itself with all Federal, State and Local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and codes affecting the performance of the work, including the cost of permits and licenses required for the work; determine the character, quality, and quantities of the work to be performed and the materials and equipment to be provided; and correlate its observations, investigations, and determinations with all requirements of the bid. The District shall not be liable for any loss sustained by the successful bidder resulting from any variance between the actual conditions and data given in the bid documents. Bidder agrees that the submission of bid shall be incontrovertible evidence that the bidder has complied with all the requirements of this provision of the Information for Bidders.
- 8. Withdrawal of Bids. Any bid may be withdrawn, either personally or by written request signed by the bidder, at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids. The bid security for a bid withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids, in accordance with this paragraph, shall be returned. No bidder may withdraw any bid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days after the date set for the opening of bids.
- 9. Interpretation of Bid Documents. If any bidder is in doubt as to the true meaning of any

part of the bid documents, or finds discrepancies in, or omissions from the bid documents, a written request for an interpretation or correction thereof must be submitted to District in writing, via email to_dmccready@pusdk12.org, <u>JasonM@StudioW-Architects.com</u> and <u>MicheleG@StudioW-Architects.com</u> on or before 9:00 a.m. on February 13, 2023. No requests shall be considered after this time. The bidder submitting the written request shall be responsible for its prompt delivery. Any interpretation or correction of the bid documents will be made solely at District discretion and only by written addendum duly issued by the District, and a copy of such addendum will be hand delivered, emailed or faxed to each bidder known to have received a set of bid documents. No person is authorized to make any oral interpretation of any provision in the bid documents, nor shall any oral interpretation of bid documents be binding on the District. If there are discrepancies of any kind in the bid documents, the interpretation of the District shall prevail. SUBMITTAL OF A BID WITHOUT A REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATIONS SHALL BE INCONTROVERTIBLE EVIDENCE THAT THE BIDDER HAS DETERMINED THAT THE BID DOCUMENTS ARE ACCEPTABLE AND SUFFICIENT FOR BIDDING AND COMPLETING THE WORK; AND THAT THE BIDDER IS CAPABLE OF READING, FOLLOWING AND COMPLETING THE WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS.

- 10. <u>Bidders Interested in More Than One Bid</u>. No person, firm or corporation shall be allowed to make, or file, or be interested in more than one (1) bid for the same work unless alternate bids are specifically called for by the District. A person, firm, or corporation that has submitted a subproposal to a bidder, or that has quoted prices of materials to a bidder, is not thereby disqualified from submitting a proposal or quoting prices to other bidders or submitting a bid.
- 11. Agreement. The form of Agreement, which the successful bidder, as CONTRACTOR, will be required to execute, is included in the bid documents and should be carefully examined by the bidder. The Agreement will be executed in two (2) original counterparts. The complete Agreement consists of the following but not limited to the Notice Calling for Bids, Calendar of Events, Information for Bidders, Bid Form, Bid Form Pricing Sheet, Bid Bond, Non-collusion Declaration, Certification of Primary Participant Regarding Debarment, Suspension & Other Related Matters, Certificate of Lobbying, Requirements for CONTRACTORs Working on a Public Works Project Form, Payment Bond, Tobacco Use of Policy, Workers' Compensation Certificate, Agreement, Drug-Free Workplace Certification, Criminal Records Check Certification, W-9, all insurance requirements, General Conditions, and all modifications, addenda and amendments, if any (hereinafter Bid Documents), thereof duly incorporated therein. All of above documents are intended to cooperate and be complementary so that any instructions or requirements called for in one and not mentioned in the other, or vice versa, are to be executed the same as if mentioned in all said documents. The intention of the documents is to include all labor, materials, equipment, transportation and services necessary for the proper delivery of all items called for in the Agreement.

- 12. <u>Contract Award.</u> The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, or all bids will be rejected.
- 13. Insurance and Workers' Compensation. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish certificates and endorsements evidencing that the required insurance is in effect as set forth in the Agreement. District may request that such certificates and endorsements are completed on District provided forms. In accordance with the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code, the successful bidder shall secure the payment of compensation to all employees. The successful bidder who has been awarded the contract shall sign and file with District prior to performing the work, the Workers' Compensation Certificate included as a part of the proposal documents. Labor Code section 1861.

The successful bidder will be required to provide and maintain insurance as set forth in the Agreement.

- 14. <u>Anti-Discrimination</u>. In connection with all work performed under this bid, there shall be no unlawful discrimination against any prospective or active employee engaged in the work because of race, color, ancestry, national origin, religious creed, sex, age, marital status, physical disability, mental disability, or medical condition. The successful bidder agrees to comply with applicable Federal and State laws including, but not limited to, the California Fair Employment and Housing Act, beginning with Government Code Section 12900 and Labor Code Section 1735.
- 15. <u>Hold Harmless/Indemnification</u>. The successful bidder will be required to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the District and its trustees, officers, agents, and employees, as set forth in the Agreement.
- 16. Brand Names and Model Numbers (if applicable). Brand names are included for descriptive purposes, to indicate the quality, design and utility desired. Brand names and model numbers where specified have been shown due to existing standards. Specific makes and models are required in some circumstances in order to be compatible with existing District equipment. This specification is not intended to restrict competition. Brands of equal make or type to those specified are acceptable unless otherwise indicated in this bid request. Requests for substitution of an "or equal" material, product, thing, or service must comply with the procedures set forth in section 17, below. Recycled products must also meet the requirements set forth in the bid. Bidders may find discrepancies in the model numbers given in that the model number may be an old one and the item is not referred to by a new number. Consideration will be given in that situation. Please note that bid is for the same item as specified by designating "New Number" in the Brand/Model area, should that be the case. Inquiries regarding such discrepancies are to be made in accordance with

- Section 9: Interpretation of Bid Documents in the Information for Bidders.
- 17. Substitutions (if applicable). All items bid must conform to the terms and conditions set forth in these bid documents. The District reserves the right to reject all bids that do not conform to the bid. Should the bidder wish to request any substitution, the bidder shall submit a written request to the District within the timeframe stated for Requests for Substitutions deadline (noted on the Calendar of Events). At a minimum, descriptive technical literature (manufacturer's specifications and a picture of the specific item), marked with the appropriate bid item number, should be provided fully describing the claimed "or equal" product. Suitability and valuation of "equals" rest in the sole discretion of the District. Request for substitution received after the timeframe stated for Requests for Substitutions deadline (noted on the Calendar of Events) will not be considered. If the substituted item is acceptable, the District will approve it in an Addendum issued to all bidders of record. It is understood and agreed to by the bidder that the District reserves the right to reject any such proposed substitution. If the material, process, service, or equipment offered by the bidder is not, in the sole opinion of the District, then the bidder expressly understands and agrees that bidder shall furnish the material, process, service, or equipment specified by the District.
- 18. <u>Deviations from Bid Terms and Conditions</u>. Material deviations from any bid term or condition shall cause a bid to be rejected as nonresponsive.
- 19. <u>Warranty/Quality</u>. The CONTRACTOR will warrant the work as set forth in the Agreement.
- 20. <u>Delivery</u>. Destination will be designated within the boundaries of the Paradise Unified School District. Actual delivery dates should be coordinated with the District. All shipments shall be accompanied by a packing slip. Purchase order number shall appear on all packing slips, invoices, and packages. **Bid all items F.O.B., Paradise Unified School District any of its locations within the District boundaries**.
- 21. <u>Drug-Free Workplace Certification</u>. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 8350, et seq., the successful bidder will be required to execute a Drug-Free Workplace Certification upon execution of the Agreement. The bidder will be required to take positive measures outline in the certification in order to ensure the presence of a drug-free workplace. Failure to abide with the conditions set forth in the Drug-Free Workplace Act could result in penalties including termination of the Agreement or suspension of payment thereunder.
- 22. <u>Non-collusion Declaration</u>. In accordance with the provisions of Section 7106 of the Public Contract Code, each bid must be accompanied by a Non-collusion Declaration.

- 23. <u>Tobacco-Free Policy</u>. The successful bidder shall agree to enforce a tobacco-free work site and shall submit the completed Tobacco Use Policy.
- 24. <u>Criminal Records Check</u>. The successful bidder will be required to comply with the applicable requirements of Education Code Section 45125.1 with respect to fingerprinting of employees and must complete the Criminal Records Check Certification.
- 25. <u>Public Information</u>. All materials received by the District in response to this bid shall be made available to the public. If any part of a bidders' material is proprietary or confidential, the bidder must identify and so state, and be submitted separate of the bid documents. Any bidder information used to aid in bid selection must not be restricted from the public.
- 26. Debarment, Suspension, and Other Responsibility Matters. As required by Executive Order 12549, Debarment & Suspension, and implemented at 34 CFR Part 85, Bidder must certify that its principals are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from transactions with any federal department or agency. Submission of a signed bid in response to this solicitation is certification that Bidder is not currently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this transaction by any state or federal department or agency. Submission is also agreement that Paradise Unified School District will be notified of any change in this status. Certification of Primary Participant regarding Debarment, Suspension, and other Responsibility Matters and Certification of Restriction on Lobbying must be completed and submitted at the time of the bid due date or the bidder may be declared as nonresponsive.
- 27. <u>Force Majeure</u>. The parties to the Agreement may be excused from performance during the time and to the extent that they are prevented from obtaining, delivering or performing as set forth in the Agreement.
- 28. <u>Department of Industrial Relations (DIR), Labor Code & Prevailing Wages for Public</u>
 Works:

This is a public work, as it requires installation services. The successful bidder is required to comply with Labor Code, including the requirement to pay prevailing wages, and Public Contract Code provisions, as applicable.

All bidders will be required to be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations. The "Requirements for CONTRACTORs Working on a Public Works Project" form is included in the bid documents and must be submitted with the bidder' proposal.

Per the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR), no contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. That would include a firm that subcontracts to perform services such as soils testing, surveying, and building/construction inspection, and anyone hired by the firm to perform those same services as an independent contractor. Please also note that Labor Code section 1725.5(a)(2)(A) requires workers' compensation coverage for any worker employed by a registered public works contractor unless that worker is separately registered with D.I.R. as a public works contractor. As required by Section 1773 of the California Labor Code, the California Department of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for the locality in which the work is to be performed for the Project. Copies of these wage rate determinations, entitled Prevailing Wage Scale, are maintained at the District office located 6696 Clark Road, Paradise, CA, and are available at the following website: http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/DPreWageDetermination.htm. It shall be mandatory to whom the contract is awarded to pay not less than the specified rates to all workers employed by them for the Project.

The successful bidder and any listed subcontractor(s) of this Project are subject to the oversight monitoring and enforcement of prevailing wage requirements by the D.I.R., Division of Labor Standards Enforcement. - 6. The bidder hereby warrants that the bidder has all appropriate licenses and permits to perform the work as specified in the bid documents and that such licenses and permits will be in force and effect throughout the Agreement.
- 7. The bidder, whether manufacturer, supplier, distributor or retailer, hereby certifies that the products offered under this bid have been placed in regular commercial use for a period of at least three (3) years and that adequate spare parts exist in the marketplace for the items sold.
- 8. In submitting this bid, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted, it will assign to the DISTRICT all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may have under Section 4 of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. Section 15) or under the Cartwright Act (Business & Professions Code Section 16700, et seq.) arising from purchases of goods, materials, or services by the bidder for sale to the DISTRICT pursuant to the bid.  - 4.2.2. For each calendar day of delay in the removal and disposal of the existing furniture, through July 23, 2023, Contractor shall pay \$1,000.00 in liquidated damages.

The Liquated damage assessments provided in 4.2.1 and 4.2.2 are cumulative.

4.2.3. For each calendar day of delay in completion of the entire Work, after July 23, 2023, Contractor shall pay \$3,000.00 in liquidated damages.

5. Changes to the Work.

- 5.1. DISTRICT may, in its discretion, change the Work, adding or deleting goods or services to be furnished or performed. Any change to the Work must be directed in a writing signed by DISTRICT. CONTRACTOR will not be compensated for changes made without a written directive.
- 5.2. If any change directed by DISTRICT increases or decreases the cost or time for performing the Work, the Contract Price or the Contract Time will be adjusted accordingly. The parties will undertake in good faith to reach agreement as to the Contract Price or Contract Time adjustment. Such agreement shall be memorialized by Change Order signed by the parties. If the parties cannot agree as to the Contract Price or Contract Time adjustment, the following shall occur:
 - 5.2.1. CONTRACTOR shall perform the change to the Work as directed by DISTRICT;
 - 5.2.2. DISTRICT shall determine and implement appropriate adjustment to the Contract Price or Contract Time; and
 - 5.2.3. CONTRACTOR may appeal DISTRICT's determination under Section 19, Resolution

of Disputes.

6. Termination.

- 6.1. DISTRICT may terminate this Agreement at any time and require CONTRACTOR to cease all work under this Agreement by providing CONTRACTOR ten (10) days prior written notice of termination. Upon receipt of notice, CONTRACTOR shall:
 - 6.1.1. Cease performance of the Work and immediately direct its subcontractors and suppliers to cease such operations, as well;
 - 6.1.2. Take any actions that is necessary, or that DISTRICT may direct, for the protection and preservation of the Work; and
 - 6.1.3. Continue to maintain any insurance required by this Agreement.
- 6.2. If the termination is for DISTRICT's convenience, and not for cause, CONTRACTOR will be paid for completed Work delivered or performed in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. CONTRACTOR shall have no other claim or entitlement to payment by DISTRICT by reason of this Agreement.

7. Indemnity.

- 7.1. CONTRACTOR will indemnify and hold harmless DISTRICT and its trustees, officers, agents, and employees from every claim or demand made, and every liability, loss, damage, or expense, of any nature whatsoever, for any injury to or death of any person, including the employees of CONTRACTOR or any subcontractor, or damage, loss, or theft of any property arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the Work.
- 7.2. CONTRACTOR shall defend any and all actions, suits, or other proceedings that may be brought or instituted against DISTRICT or its trustee, officers, agents, or employees, on any such claim, demand, or liability, and shall pay or satisfy any judgment that may be rendered against DISTRICT or its trustees, officers, agents, or employees in any action, suit, or other proceedings as a result thereof.
- 7.3. These obligations to defend and indemnify shall survive completion of the Work.

8. Inspection of the Work.

DISTRICT may, in its discretion and at its convenience, inspect the Work. DISTRICT shall promptly notify CONTRACTOR of any non-conforming Work of which it has actual knowledge. However, DISTRICT's failure to inspect or failure to provide notice of non-conforming Work shall not relieve CONTRACTOR from any obligation to fulfill this Agreement. Defective Work

10. Insurance.

- 10.1. CONTRACTOR shall provide and maintain in full force and effect, from the commencement of the Work until the expiration of this Agreement, the policy or policies of insurance, as set forth below. CONTRACTOR will provide an endorsement to this policy(s) stating, "Such insurance as is afforded by this policy shall be primary, and any insurance carried by DISTRICT shall be excess and noncontributory." In addition, CONTRACTOR will have named DISTRICT and its trustees, officers, agents, and employees as additional insureds under said policy. No later than five (5) calendar days after the execution of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall provide DISTRICT with certificates of insurance evidencing all coverages and endorsements required below, and including a provision for a thirty (30) day written notice of cancellation or reduction in coverage.

12. Assignment of Agreement; Subcontracts.

12.1. CONTRACTOR shall not assign, transfer, convey, sublet, or otherwise dispose of this Agreement or of its rights, title, or interest in or to the same or any part thereof. CONTRACTOR shall indemnify, hold harmless, and defend DISTRICT against any and all actions, proceedings, penalties, or claims arising out of the failure to comply.

16. Warranties of Condition and Performance.

In addition to any warranties provided by a manufacturer, and notwithstanding any disclaimer of warranties or damages by a manufacturer, CONTRACTOR warrants that the goods shall strictly conform to the requirements of this Agreement an shall be of merchantable quality, fit for the purposes for which such goods are intended, and free from defect in design, materials, or manufacture.

17. Public Works Contract Requirements.

- 17.1. This is a public work, as it involves furniture removal, disposal, and installation services. CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors are subject to the requirements of Chapter 1, Part 7 of the Labor Code, commencing with section 1720, pertaining to public works, and are responsible for ascertaining and applying those requirements. Any person who willfully violates Article 2 of Chapter 1 (Wages) is guilty of a misdemeanor. See Labor Code section 1777. Violations may also result in debarment. See Labor Code section 1777.1.
- 17.2. Not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the Work is performed, and not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for holiday and overtime work fixed as provided in Chapter 1, Part 7 of the Labor Code, shall be paid for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute this Agreement. CONTRACTOR, and any subcontractor under it, shall be subject to penalties under Labor Code section 1775 for paying less than the prevailing wage rates.
- 17.3. Copies of the prevailing rates of per diem wages are on file at DISTRICT's office and shall be made available on request. Alternatively, said rates are accessible on the INTERNET under the heading "General Prevailing Wage Determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations pursuant to California Labor Code Part 7, Chapter 1, Article 2, Sections 1770, 1773 and 1773.1." The Internet address is http://www.dir.ca.gov/.
- 17.4. CONTRACTOR shall cause a copy of the prevailing rate of per diem wages to be posted at the Work site.
- 17.5. CONTRACTOR and any subcontractor under it shall keep accurate payroll records

showing the name, address, social security number, work classification, straight time and overtime hours worked each day and week, and the actual per diem wages paid to each journeyman, apprentice, worker, or other employee employed by it in connection with the Work, and shall certify and make those records available for inspection and otherwise comply with the provisions of Labor Code sections 1776 and 1812. CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors are subject to a penalty assessment for a failure to comply with these requirements. Any person who neglects to comply with the provisions of section 1776, pertaining to payroll records, is guilty of a misdemeanor. See also Labor Code section 1814.

- 17.6. CONTRACTOR and any subcontractor under it shall be subject to the provisions of Labor Code section 1777.5 pertaining to the employment of apprentices.

 CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors shall pay every apprentice employed in the execution of this Agreement the prevailing rate of per diem wages for apprentices in the trade to which he or she is registered, and shall otherwise comply with the provisions of that section. CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors are subject to penalty assessments under Labor Code sections 17777.6 and 1777.7 for a failure to comply with these requirements. CONTRACTOR and any subcontractors working under it shall not refuse to accept qualified employees as registered apprentices on any basis listed in subdivision (a) of section 12940 of the Government Code.
- 17.7. CONTRACTOR warrants that neither it nor any of its subcontractors is ineligible to work on public works projects pursuant to section 1777.1 or 1777.7 of the Labor Code. CONTRACTOR is prohibited from performing work on this Agreement with an ineligible subcontractor.
- 17.8. CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors shall not discriminate in the employment of persons upon this Work on any basis listed in subdivision (a) of section 12940 of the Government Code. CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors shall be subject to penalties for violations of this prohibition, as provided in Labor Code section 1735.
- 17.9. The time of service of any worker employed in the execution of this Agreement is limited and restricted to 8 hours during any one calendar day, and 40 hours during any one calendar week, except that work performed by CONTRACTOR's employees in excess of 8 hours per day, and 40 hours during any one week, shall be permitted upon compensation for all hours worked in excess of 8 hours per day at not less than 11/2 times the basic rate of pay, or at any higher rate of overtime pay that may be required pursuant to a Department of Industrial Relations prevailing wage determination. CONTRACTOR, or any subcontractor working under it, shall be subject to penalties under Labor Code section 1813 for violations of these limitations.
- 17.10. CONTRACTOR shall secure the payment of worker's compensation to its employees performing the Work, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 1860 and 3700 of

the Labor Code and, in case any such Work is sublet, CONTRACTOR shall require the subcontractor similarly to comply with those provisions.

17.11. The Work is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. CONTRACTOR shall post job site notices, as prescribed by regulation. CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors shall retain records specified in Labor Code section 1776 (see, Subdivision (e), above) for at least three (3) years after completion of the Work.

18. Payment Bond.

- 18.1. Before commencement of work, CONTRACTOR shall deliver to DISTRICT a payment bond on the form supplied by DISTRICT in an amount equal to the Contract Price. The bond shall comply with requirements of Division 4, Part 6, Title 3, Chapter 5 of the Civil Code, commencing with Section 9550.
- 18.2. The bond shall be in the form of a bond and not a deposit in lieu of a bond.
- 18.3. Each surety for the bond shall be an "admitted surety insurer," as defined in Code of Civil Procedure section 995.120, and shall be named in the current US Department of Treasury Listing of Approved Sureties (Department Circular 570).

19. Resolution of Disputes.

Disputes between CONTRACTOR and DISTRICT arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the Work shall be resolved in accordance with Public Contract Code sections 9204 and 20104–20104.6.

20. Force Majeure.

The parties to the Agreement shall be excused from performance during the time and to the extent that they are prevented from obtaining, delivering, or performing by act of God, fire, or commandeering of materials, products, plants or facilities by the government, when satisfactory evidence thereof is presented, provided that it is satisfactorily established that the non-performance is not due to the fault or neglect of the party not performing. Foreseeable supply chain delays are accounted for in the Contract Price and the Contract Time and will not excuse performance of any term of this Agreement.

21. Integration.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties. No other agreements, oral or written, pertaining to the Work, exist between the parties. This Agreement can be modified only by an amendment in writing, approved by DISTRICT's Board of Trustees and signed by both parties

22. Applicable Law; Venue.

The laws of the State of California shall govern in the case of disputes regarding the terms of this Agreement. Venue for any action to interpret or enforce the terms of this Agreement shall reside only in the State of California, Butte County Superior Court.

NOTICE REGARDING CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK EDUCATION CODE SECTION 45125.1

Education Code Section 45125.1 provides that if the employees of any entity that has a contract with a school district may have any contact with pupils, those employees shall submit or have submitted their fingerprints in a manner authorized by the Department of Justice together with a fee determined by the Department of Justice to be sufficient to reimburse the Department for its costs incurred in processing the application.

The Department of Justice shall ascertain whether the individual whose fingerprints were submitted to it has been arrested or convicted of any crime insofar as that fact can be ascertained from information available to the Department. When the Department of Justice ascertains that an individual whose fingerprints were submitted to it has a pending criminal proceeding for a violent felony listed in Penal Code Section 1192.7(c), or has been convicted of such a felony, the Department shall notify the employer designated by the individual of the criminal information pertaining to the individual. The contractor shall certify in writing to the governing board of the school district that none of its employees who may come in contact with pupils have been convicted of a violent or serious felony.

Penal Code Section 1192.7 lists the following "serious" felonies: murder; voluntary manslaughter; mayhem; rape; sodomy by force; oral copulation by force; a lewd or lascivious act on a child under the age of 14 years; any felony punishable by death or imprisonment in the state prison for life; any felony in which the defendant personally inflicts great bodily injury on another, or in which the defendant personally uses a firearm; attempted murder; assault with intent to commit rape or robbery; assault with a deadly weapon on a peace officer; assault by a life prisoner on a non-inmate; assault with a deadly weapon by an inmate; arson; exploding a destructive device with intent to injure or to murder, or explosion causing great bodily injury or mayhem; burglary of an inhabited dwelling; robbery or bank robbery;

kidnapping; holding of a hostage by a person confined in a state prison; attempt to commit a felony punishable by death or imprisonment in the state prison for life; any felony in which the defendant personally uses a dangerous or deadly weapon; selling or furnishing specified controlled substances to a minor; penetration of genital or anal openings by foreign objects against the victim's will; grand theft involving a firearm; carjacking; and a conspiracy to commit specified controlled substances offenses.
